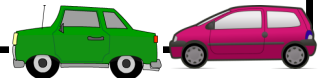
We are also encouraging our neighbors

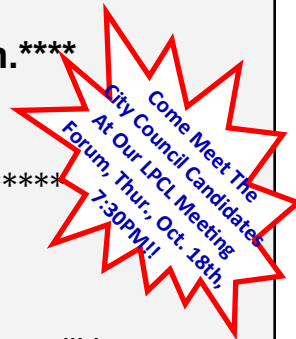

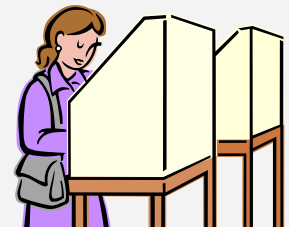
Long Point Civic League Executive Board Elections
